Dear Parent/Carer

An update for parents/carers following the announcement of a local lockdown in Conwy

As you will have heard, Conwy County will begin a local lockdown period starting at 18:00 on the Thursday 1st of October.

We want to reassure you that the lockdown period will not affect schools, and your children will be able to continue attending school, college and childcare settings as usual, but with the additional measures that schools have put in place.

The recent rise in Coronavirus cases in Conwy is a cause for concern, and it is important that everyone plays their part in the fight against the virus. In terms of education, our schools are continuing to work hard to ensure that there is a safe environment for your children within the school.

Outside of school, we need to work together to make sure we all follow the rules of the lockdown and in particular this means:

- You and your children should not visit family and friends **inside** their homes;
- You should ensure social distancing of two meters outside the school gates;
- Your children should not share cars with other family members who they do not live with;
- Your children should not attend parties and other social occasions;
- You and your children should wash your hands frequently and thoroughly;
- You must not send your children to school if they have one of the symptoms of COVID-19 namely high temperature, new persistent cough or loss of smell or taste;
- You must arrange a test for any family member who shows symptoms and self-isolate as a family while awaiting the test result;
- You must follow any instructions you receive from the Test, Track and Protect service following the test result.

We understand how difficult this year has been for many young people, but by following these guidelines and working together, we help to keep our children, ourselves, our community and Conwy safe and ensure that schools can remain open and our children can continue to keep learning.
