Lessons available include:

- WOODWIND** Flute, Clarinet, Oboe, Bassoon, Saxophone
- BRASS** Trumpet, Trombone, Cornet, Baritone, French Horn, Euphonium, Tuba
- STRING** Violin, Viola, Harp, Cello, Double Bass
- PERCUSSION** Drum Kit, Orchestral Percussion
- VOCAL** Classical, Modern, Music Theatre
- GUITAR** Acoustic, Electric
- KEYBOARD** Electric Keyboard, Piano.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 30 lessons over three terms (unevenly spread across the three terms due to school timetable, GCSE’s etc.)* ● An opportunity to borrow from an instrument free of charge for two years (subject to availability - guitarists, drummers, harpists & keyboard players must have their own instrument) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Attend every lesson (punctually) unless absent from school. ** ● Practice daily on the instrument (parents/guardians to encourage their children in this.)

***The school does not make any profit from this service and has to pay the tutors even if your child decides to stop before the end of the school year.**
****Please note that instrumental agreements are binding on a yearly basis and no refunds can be made for students who do not continue to attend lessons.**

How much does it cost and how do we pay?

- £50 per term, £150 a year.
- £25 per term for a **second instrument** or if there is an **older sibling** taking lessons at £50.
- £8.80 per term if a student receives **Free School Meals**.
- Payable on Parent pay under 'Music Lessons'
- **Year 11/13 students** are reminded that their 30 lessons will make it necessary to attend lessons during their study leave and they will need to pay for the full year like all other students but in **2 instalments of £75 payable at the start of terms 1 and 2**.
- Please return the completed contract with the payment made on parent pay to **student services**.
- **IMPORTANT - First term payment due in advance on or before 13th September 2019.**
